

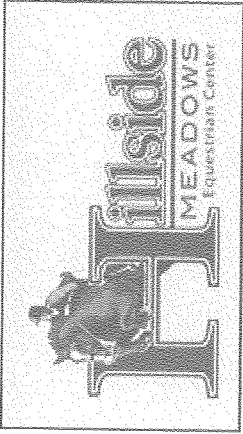
RULES and INFORMATION

- ◆ Pre-entries with payment MUST be received the Thursday prior to each show-no exceptions. Post-entry fee is \$10 per rider. Entry fees are \$10 per class.
- ◆ NO dogs allowed, regardless of leash.
- ◆ Leadline, Huntseat riders under 18, and all riders showing over fences must wear an approved helmet. Non-huntseat riders will not be penalized for wearing a helmet.
- ◆ Either neat informal attire or formal attire is acceptable.
- ◆ Negative Coggins test & proof of Rabies vaccination within one year required for entry.
- ◆ All ages are as of January 1, 2011. These ages will carry through for the entire show series.
- ◆ The judge's decisions are final. HMWSS reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes as entries warrant.
- ◆ Each rider will be given one number, please keep this number for the series, even if you changes horses, your number will not change, and any points accumulated will stay with the rider.
- ◆ Parking, warm-up and lunging will be in designated areas only. The shows will be held in the rear left indoor arena, furthest back from the road.
- ◆ Limited stalls are available for \$20 per day, call ahead to reserve. Contact Charlene Clouthier (774) 293-0024
- ◆ High Point Series Awards, No minimum number of shows to attend to qualify. The highest points per rider per division determines the winner.
- ◆ In the event of a tie for Day End/Series End High Points, the placing in Horsemanship/Equitation will be used to break the tie.
- ◆ Day End/Series End High Point awards will be based upon the following point system. 1st-7 pts, 2nd-5 pts, 3rd-4 pts, 4th-3 pts, 5th-2 pts, 6th-1 pt.
- ◆ Green Horse division is a schooling division. Training equipment and 2 hands for western riders with a curb bit is permitted.
- ◆ Dates for the show series are as follows: November 6, December 4, January 8, February 5, March 4.
